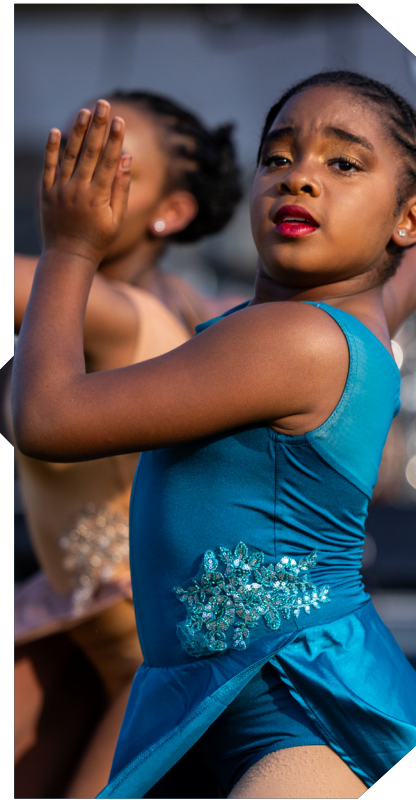

## THE PROCESS

The process to establish this year's strategic goals commenced in late 2024, when City leadership determined that a comprehensive review of the existing Strategic Plan's Focus Areas and Initiatives was warranted to ensure their continued alignment with current community conditions and the City Council's strategic priorities. The previous Strategic Plan, developed in 2018 and updated periodically, identified specific projects and process improvements consistent with the Plan's established initiatives.

Development of the new Strategic Plan began with individual interviews with City Council Members and culminated in a Council Work Session. During this session, the following items were examined: a comprehensive SWOT Analysis (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats); articulation of a shared vision for a successful Bedford; identification of Council's key areas of focus; establishment of long-term goals; and a comparative review of the 2018 initiatives relative to current priorities.

Going forward, City leadership will assess projects, processes, and policy enhancements in relation to the adopted Strategic Focus Areas. An accompanying Action Plan will delineate specific efforts associated with these Focus Areas and Initiatives and will be updated periodically to reflect the initiation and completion of projects.

**REGULAR SESSION**

The Regular Session began at 6:00 p.m.

**CALL TO ORDER/GENERAL COMMENTS**

Mayor Cogan called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION**

Bishop Nosa Onaiwu, Arise and Shine International Ministries gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Pledges of Allegiance to the flags of the United States and Texas were given.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Mark Ritchie, 1604 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Mr. Ritchie signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mr. Ritchie addressed the City Council to oppose the planned installation of a Type III barricade at the end of his street. He argued that, based on his research of the Texas traffic control guidelines (MUTCD), other acceptable alternatives exist and that the

City has not adequately explained the alleged safety hazards that justify the barricade. Mr. Ritchie also questioned whether the City followed required planning, reporting, and notification procedures, noting that an initial proposed placement could have blocked access to his driveway. He requested greater transparency, access to relevant reports, and an opportunity to meet with City officials to discuss alternative solutions supported by neighborhood residents.

Rebecca Ritchie, 1604 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Mrs. Ritchie signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mrs. Ritchie urged the City Council to reconsider plans to install large Type III barricades at the end of her street, stating that they are intended for construction zones and roadway closures rather than quiet neighborhoods. She stated that residents have not received adequate explanations or engineering studies to justify the \$9,000 project, despite repeated requests and more than 50 signatures collected in opposition. Mrs. Ritchie noted that the street already has a 90-foot grassy buffer before a ravine and suggested lower-cost alternatives, including dead-end signs, an end-of-road marker, and lighting, which she estimated would cost about \$300. She asked to pause the installation, share any engineering analysis, and provide residents with greater transparency and involvement in the decision-making process.

Glenn Martin, 1605 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Mr. Martin signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mr. Martin stated that he lives across from the proposed barricade location, supported Rebecca Ritchie's concerns and said residents were not notified before the City initially began assembling the barricade. While acknowledging the City's need to address liability concerns, he argued that a simple dead-end sign placed before the last intersection would be a more effective, less intrusive, and far less expensive solution. Mr. Martin noted that very little traffic uses the area—fewer than five nonresident vehicles per week—and that an earlier warning sign would further reduce unnecessary traffic. He urged the Council to consider the dead-end sign as a practical alternative to the barricade

Mary Jensen, 1612 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Mrs. Jensen signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mrs. Jensen, a local realtor, argued that the proposed barricade could negatively affect nearby property values by creating external obsolescence—an outside factor that diminishes a home's appeal and value. She stated that, based on appraisal industry guidance, such a structure could reduce property values and significantly shrink the pool of potential buyers for homes near the site. Mrs. Jensen supported the Ritchies' position and urged the City to consider less intrusive alternatives.

Dalton Franklin, 1612 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Mr. Franklin signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mr. Franklin argued that City decisions should be evaluated not only for safety and regulatory compliance but also for their financial impact on homeowners, property values, and the City's tax base. Drawing on his experience with costly irrigation well investments encouraged by the City, he cautioned against implementing large barriers and excessive signage that could reduce neighborhood appeal and home values. He urged City leaders to reconsider the proposed barriers and signage and explore alternatives that achieve safety goals while better preserving neighborhood character, accessibility, and property values.

Robin Lynch, 18 Kingston Court, Bedford – Ms. Lynch signed up to speak about the Awareness Project Art Show and sale for special needs artists. Ms. Lynch, founder of the volunteer organization Not a Random Act, invited the community to attend an upcoming art exhibit and sale featuring artwork created by individuals with special needs. She highlighted the artists' excitement and pride in showcasing and selling their work for the first time and encouraged residents to support them by attending the event on Saturday from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., which will also feature food trucks.

## Council Minutes June 9, 2026

Ed Quincey, 3801 Cambridge Circle West, Bedford – Mr. Quincey signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mr. Quincy, a Navy veteran, urged City leaders to carefully consider the impact of barriers and traffic changes, drawing on a personal experience from his service. He described how a base commander's traffic-flow decision contributed to a severe accident involving a Marine Corps captain, emphasizing that poor decisions can have serious consequences and that not all barriers are physical—they can also negatively affect the community and its residents.

Anna Ritchie, 1604 Wimbleton Drive, Bedford – Ms. Ritchie signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Ms. Ritchie addressed the Mayor and Council to criticize the City's handling of public health and property maintenance, arguing that safety concerns extend beyond traffic issues. She said a city-owned greenbelt near her home has been allowed to grow excessively tall for years, forcing her mother to pay for private landscaping despite City ordinances requiring grass and weeds to be kept under ten inches. Ritchie also raised concerns about stagnant water and mosquito breeding in a nearby drainage ravine, noting that a mosquito sample in Bedford recently tested positive for West Nile virus and questioning whether the City is consistently carrying out mosquito-control efforts. She urged the City to apply the same level of attention to maintenance and public health hazards as it does to other safety initiatives, calling for greater consistency, responsiveness, and enforcement of its own standards.

Olivia Ritchie, 2305 Stonegate Drive North, Bedford – Mrs. Ritchie signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mrs. Ritchie stated what she sees as a conflict between the City's "Keep Bedford Beautiful" goals and the installation of large traffic barricades on residential dead-end streets. She argued that the industrial-style Type III barricades detract from neighborhood aesthetics, create the appearance of a construction zone, and may negatively affect property values, despite the City's intent to improve traffic safety and comply with federal standards. Mrs. Ritchie urged the Council to pause the broader rollout of similar installations and consider context-sensitive alternatives such as decorative bollards, landscaped barriers, or other end-of-road markers that meet safety requirements while preserving neighborhood character. She emphasized that Bedford can maintain both safety and beauty without relying on what she views as excessive or unnecessary warning infrastructure.

Brandon Ritchie, 2305 Stonegate Drive North, Bedford – Mr. Ritchie signed up to speak about the Wimbleton Drive barricade. Mr. Ritchie voiced strong opposition to the proposed Type III barricade at the end of Wimbledon Drive, arguing that it is excessive, visually intrusive, and inappropriate for a residential neighborhood. He criticized the decision-making process, claiming residents have been denied meaningful engagement with City leadership and that requests for meetings and explanations have been dismissed. Mr. Ritchie contended that the City had not provided planning or zoning reports to justify choosing what he described as the most aggressive barricade option, despite residents proposing alternative, MUTCD-compliant solutions. He urged the Mayor and Council to pause the project, release supporting documentation, and facilitate direct discussions between residents and City officials before moving forward.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

4. **Consider a resolution authorizing the City Manager or her designee to execute a design contract with Freese and Nichols, Inc. for the design of HC-1 Bank Stabilization and Sewer Design in an amount not to exceed \$383,500.**

City Engineer Marah Aqqad presented information on this item, which is to execute a design contract with Freese and Nichols, Inc. for the design of HC-1 Bank Stabilization and Sewer Design. Mrs. Aqqad stated staff is seeking approval for a \$383,500 design contract with Freese and Nichols to stabilize the HC-1 channel and replace an aging sewer line that has become exposed due to creek bank erosion. If left unaddressed, the erosion could cause sewer line failure, threatening nearby properties and City infrastructure. Based on findings from the Drainage Master Plan, staff recommends moving directly into design rather than conducting additional alternatives analysis, which would increase costs and delay the project. The project includes replacing approximately 350 feet of a 12-inch clay sewer line from 1971 and stabilizing about 400 feet of channel bank, with an estimated construction cost of \$867,000. Temporary repairs have already been completed, allowing the City time to complete design work before construction begins, likely within the next year.

In response to questions from Council, Mrs. Aqqad stated that this item is for the project design, which will take about a year to complete; the construction project will go to bid and begin next summer; and that funding will come from the Stormwater Fund.

Motioned by Councilmember Donovan Brandon, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Dawkins to approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager or her designee to execute a design contract with Freese and Nichols, Inc. for the design of HC-1 Bank Stabilization and Sewer Design in an amount not to exceed \$383,500.

Motion approved 6-0-0. Mayor Cogan declared the motion carried.

**REPORTS**

**5. Mayor/Council Member Reports**

Mayor Cogan reported on attending the Bedford Park HOA meeting to provide updates on City projects, including the vision for Bedford Commons. Residents were supportive of the plans and requested ongoing communication about future decisions and developments.

Mayor Cogan also attended the Mayors' Council meeting, which focused on preparations for the upcoming FIFA World Cup in the Dallas–Fort Worth area. While visitor numbers and hotel bookings may be lower than initially expected, Tarrant County Public Health is preparing for potential health risks associated with international travel. Officials plan to monitor wastewater for signs of new viruses or diseases and coordinate with local hospitals, demonstrating proactive efforts to protect public health during the event.

Mayor Pro Tem Dawkins reported on the HEB Expo; the upcoming Juneteenth Celebration, and the next Beautification meeting will be held June 15.

Councilmember Donovan Brandon reported on the upcoming Flag Ball event at Pennington Field on July 12, and the next Library Board meeting will be held in August.

Councilmember Sabol had nothing to report.

Councilmember Farco reported that the HEB Expo had 93 businesses and 13 food vendors; that the Bedford Animal Shelter is under construction and that the City has partnered with the City of Euless Animal Shelter located at 301 West Euless Boulevard.

**6. City Manager/Staff Reports**

City Manager Andrea Roy discussed the demolition of the Animal Shelter; that Fire Station No. 2 has received their Certificate of Occupancy; that staff is preparing for the July 4th event and that Bedford gear will be available for purchase.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

**BACKGROUND:**

The proposed agreement is for an additional three-year term of the existing Microsoft Enterprise Agreement for the City’s continued use of various Microsoft software and storage applications. The cost of the service is an estimated amount of \$141,951 per year, for a total estimated cost of \$425,853.

The City of Bedford’s Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EA) covers usage of all Microsoft software, which includes the email server (Exchange Online), cloud file storage (One Drive), collaboration software (SharePoint and Teams), and desktop office productivity software (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.). The EA also covers the Microsoft SQL Database Server licenses, which are required for applications such as ESRI GIS System, MCRS (Court), and several others. Microsoft Azure Active Directory is also the core of the identity management system used to control access to applications City wide.

The current agreement ends June 30, 2026. The renewal will allow the City to continue using the various Microsoft products for the new term and prevent disruptions in service for existing users.

State purchasing laws, Local Government Code, Chapter 271.102 authorize local governments to enter into joint contracts and cooperative agreements for the performance of governmental functions normally associated with the operation of government such as purchasing necessary materials and supplies.

  - (i) Adding new Products not previously ordered.** New Enterprise Products or Enterprise Online Services may be added at any time by contacting a Microsoft Account Manager or Reseller. New Additional Products, other than Online Services, may be used if an order is placed in the month the Product is first used. For Additional Products that are Online Services, an initial order for the Online Service is required prior to use.

- (ii) Adding Licenses for previously ordered Products.** Additional Licenses for previously ordered Products other than Online Services may be added at any time but must be included in the next true-up order. **BACKGROUND:**

The Bedford Police Department currently utilizes Axon body-worn cameras, fleet vehicle cameras, criminal interview room cameras, TASER electronic control devices, and Axon Evidence software for digital evidence storage, records retention, and redaction. The current agreement was entered into in 2021 based on the operational needs of the Department at that time.

These systems are essential to the Department's operations and support transparency during interactions with the public. They provide objective documentation of incidents, assist in the investigation and prosecution of criminal offenses, and help address questions related to police actions.

Staff has determined that the Axon camera and TASER system continues to be the solution that best meets the needs of the Police Department and its stakeholders, including the Courts, Animal Services, the Eulesse Jail Facility, and the public. The Axon cloud-based platform provides an efficient method for storage, management, sharing, review, and redaction of digital evidence collected during documented incidents. The system also improves workflow between officers, detectives, records personnel, and the prosecutor's office through integrated case review and case submission functions.

In addition, the agreement includes warranty coverage for the full term of the contract and equipment replacement at the midpoint of the contract period. The body-worn camera system includes multiple activation triggers intended to increase transparency during critical incidents, including signal sidearm activation, TASER activation, and proximity-based activation. Axon has continued to expand the capabilities of its camera and TASER systems, improving overall effectiveness and efficiency for department personnel who rely on these tools daily.

The Axon package includes 90 body camera devices, 30 in-car cameras, 81 TASER-10 electronic control devices, the system cradle points, two interview rooms, user licenses, back-office system, mounting accessories, and the installation of all the hardware equipment. Additionally, this package includes unlimited auto-transcribe, foreign language translation, and draft one AI assisted report writing tool, all of which will make officers more efficient in documentation of recorded incidents. The 30 in-car cameras are equipped with automatic license plate reader technology, and the package further includes nine Axon outpost automatic license plate reader cameras and Axon Fusus software with 150 available camera streams.

The quote provides a total project cost of \$5,323,195.08 to be paid through ten annual installments over 120-month term. The first-year annual payment is \$530,220.15 with the remaining year's annual payment in the amount of \$532,552.77. Funding for this project will be included in the proposed FY2027 budget. State purchasing laws, Local Government Code, Chapter 271.102 authorized local government to enter into joint

contracts and cooperative agreements for the performance of governmental functions normally associated with the operation of government such as purchasing necessary materials and supplies.

Multiple systems expiring simultaneously — action needed before September 2026

## TASER Fleet — Liability Risk



Officers carry legacy TASER 7 energy weapons — past Axon's 5-Year Useful Life recommendation and out of warranty. High-voltage components degrade with age, creating field failure risk. Axon's product-liability coverage does not extend past 5 years. Current contract expires September 2026.

## Body Cameras — Contract Expiring



Current BWC contract expires September 2026. Body camera hardware and cloud storage coverage ends with the contract, leaving the department without a compliant digital evidence solution.

## No Real-Time Operations Capability



Current plan lacks real-time situational awareness — no drone detection, no ALPR cameras, no unified CCTV view for dispatch and command. Neighboring agencies already have these capabilities.

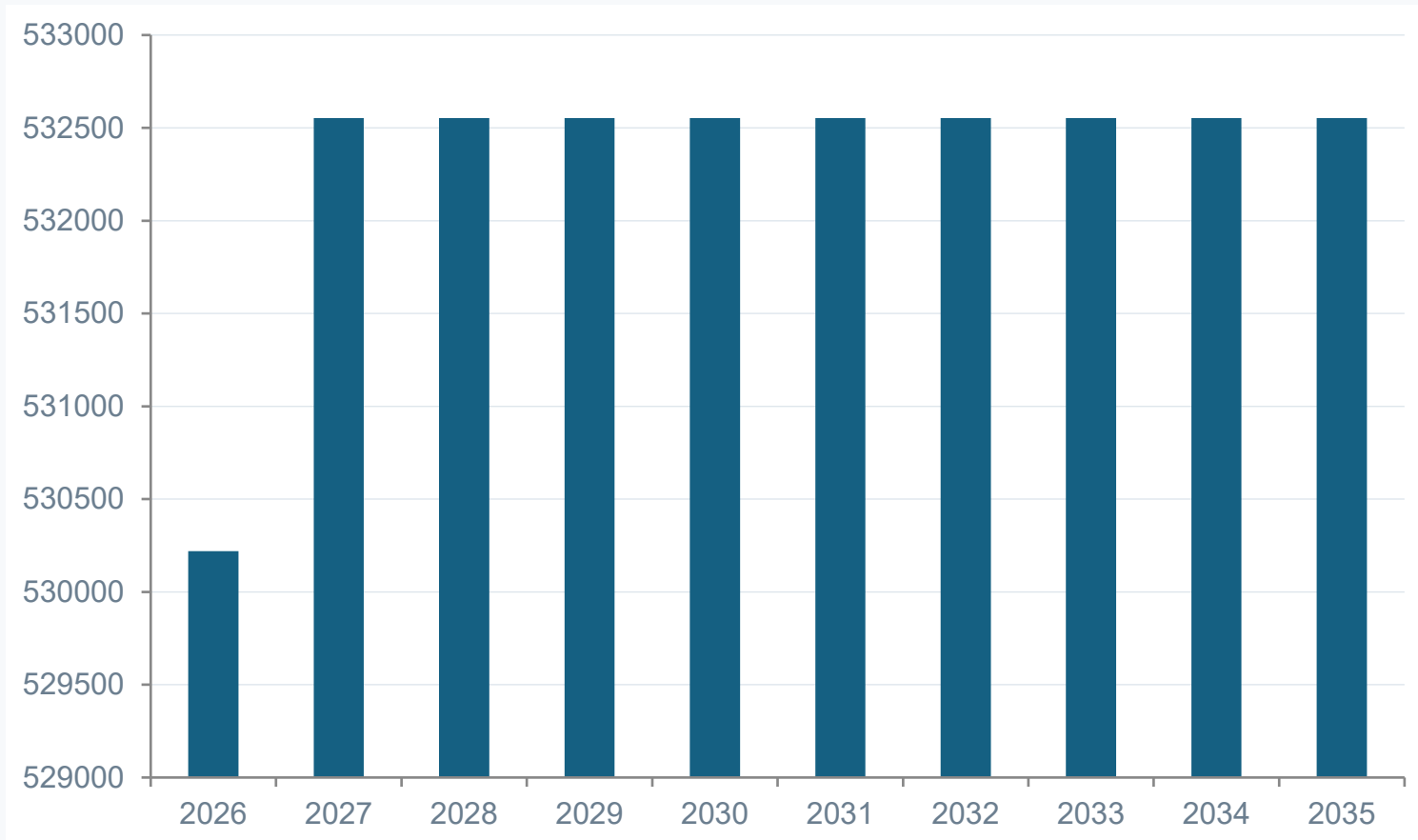

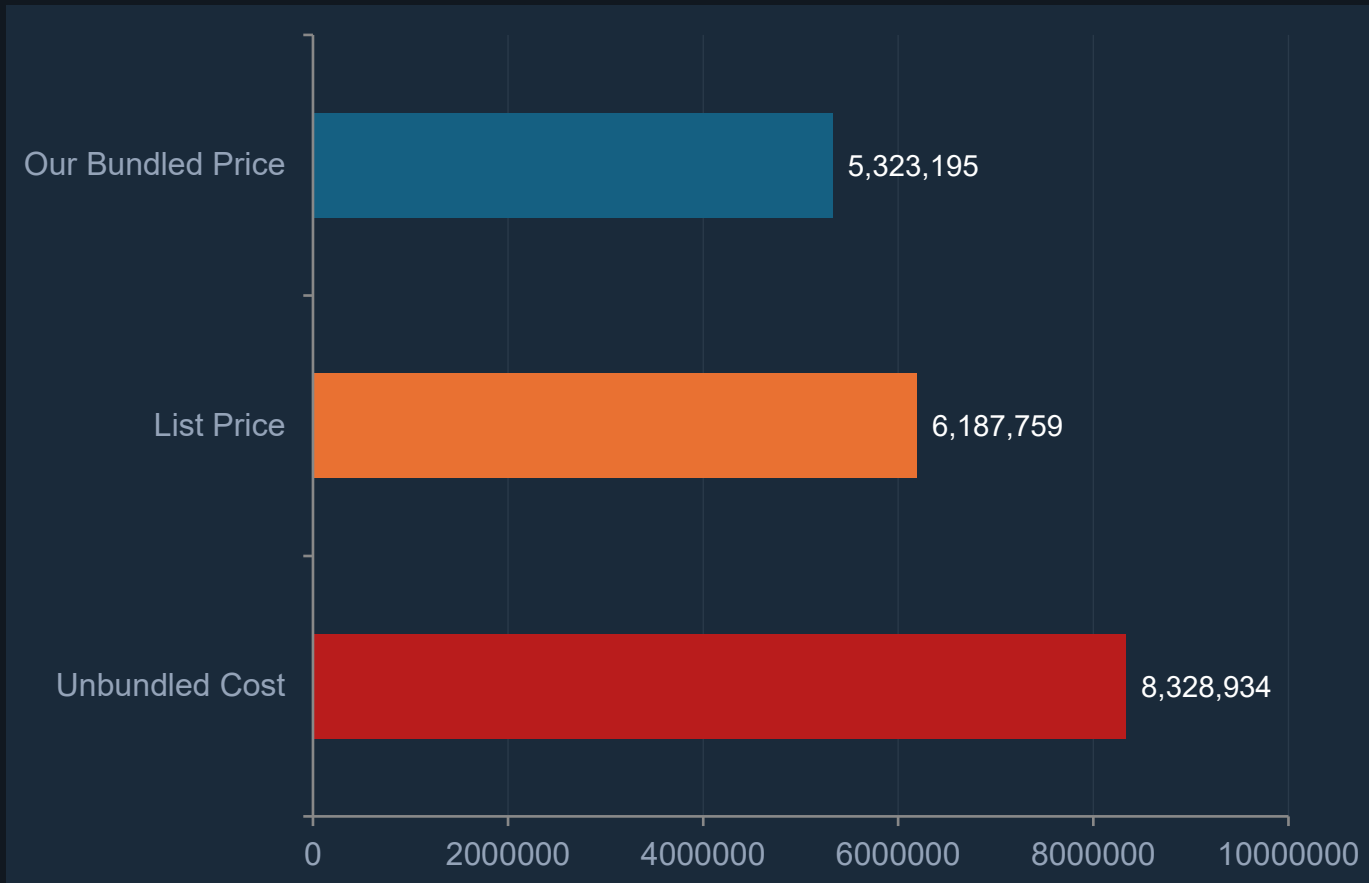

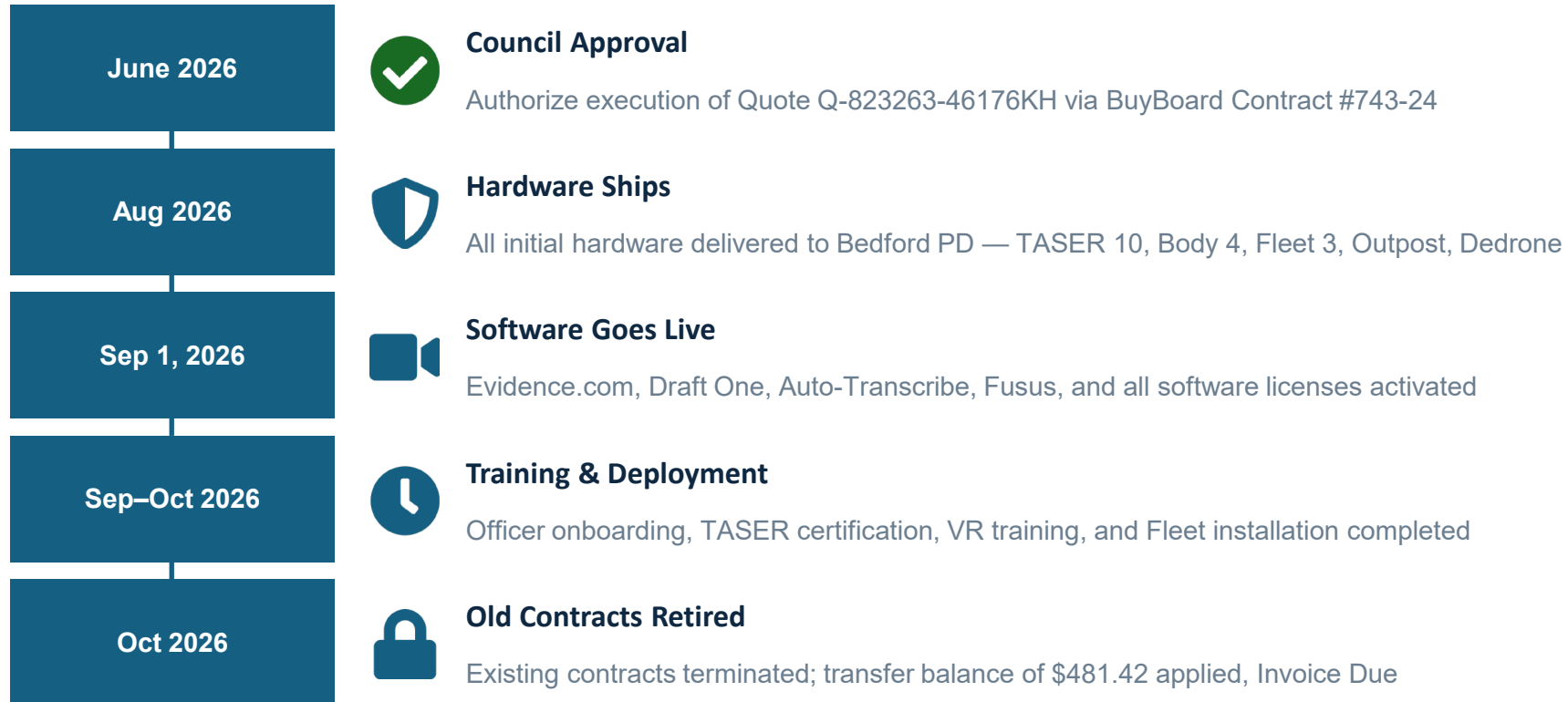
